Description:

John Forrest National Park is one of Australia's oldest conservation areas and Western Australia's first national park proclaimed in November 1900. The visitor area contains barbecue and picnic facilities and cultivated gardens of native plants. The rest of the park is largely undeveloped and is home to a variety of plant communities and wildlife.

Site Condition:

There are three entrances to the park off Great Eastern Highway. The gate at the western end of Park Road scenic drive is

locked at 4pm daily. The park contains many waterfalls and risk areas. Extreme caution must be undertaken to avoid slippage and falling in such areas.

General Notes:

John Forrest National Park is a 30 minute drive from Perth.
